

Webshots WBX File Format

Reverse Engineering by Setaou – Last update: 31 January 2006

Intro:

The WBX format is an INI-like file which define the properties of several pictures, like *Title*, *ID*, *Credits* ... WBX files are only used embedded in a WBZ file to describe the pictures contained in the file.

Layout:

There is one global section called "Header" and one section per picture to describe, whose name is the number of the picture in the file (0, 1, 2, 3 ...).

Type and values of the fields:

- Section "Header"
 - *Count*: Number of pictures described in the file.
- Section for each picture

Due to a change of the format, this section has two kinds of fields: the old and the new. I never saw a file with only the old, but current WBZ files distributed by Webshots contains WBX files with both kinds of fields.

Fields from the old format:

- *BOO_MakeWallpaper*: Boolean (0 or 1). If the value is 1, the picture is used as wallpaper as soon as the WBZ file is open.
- *FIL_ImageFileName*: Picture original filename.
- *STR_ImageTitle*: Picture title.
- *STR_ImageCredit*: Picture credit.
- *STR_ImagePID*: The first letter is the source of the picture; the following number is the picture ID.
- *STR_CollectionTitle*: Picture collection (= album).

Fields from the new format:

- *source*: Source of the picture.
- *filename*: Same as *FIL_ImageFileName*.
- *id*: Picture ID.
- *title*: Title of the picture.
- *credit*: Credit of the picture.
- *position*: *Do not really know what this represents! Seems to work fine if left empty...*
- *catTitle*: Category of the picture.
- *albumID*: Album ID.
- *albumTitle*: Album Title.
- *dailyDateYYYYMMDD*: Date when the picture has been published as the daily picture on Webshots website. The format is YYYYMMDD.
